


## AGENDA VI



The Board of Studies meet of the Department of History was held on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2018 at 10.30 a.m. The members of the board gave the following suggestions for syllabus.

- Programme and course outcome should be history oriented.
- Recommendation for library hours for U.G. & P.G.
- Appreciation of learning and writing in English language.
- Regarding evaluation pattern section A should be in the form of multiple choice questions.
- Course pattern should help to clear competitive examinations.
- Slight changes have been made by the board members related to the historical epochs.

**Course Pattern**

Regarding UG and PG Course pattern, it is not essential to have two Allied papers for UG (3 hrs) and two Elective papers for PG (4 hrs) respectively because it is superficial and we cannot render justice to the subject. Instead if Allied (6 hrs) and Elective paper (6 hrs) is taken the depth of the subject can be dealt.

In PG Course pattern World Revolutionary Thoughts is introduced in I Semester as Elective I. Archives keeping is added in II Semester as Elective III.

**Changes in the Syllabus**

Religion in India is introduced in I Semester as Core II paper. They have suggested certain topics related to Hinduism.

Historical Monuments in India is introduced in II Semester as Core IV. They have suggested slight changes in some units.

Indus Valley Civilization paper is introduced in III Semester as Allied VI. This paper is highly appreciated.

Socio-Religions Reform Movements in India is introduced in IV Semester as Allied VIII. The board suggested some Tamil Movements.

Women in Politics and Governance are added in Semester III as Skill based Elective. This paper is highly appreciated by the board.

Women Freedom fighters in India is added in Semester V as Common Core. This was highly opposed and objected by the board. The suggestions of the board are enclosed herewith. The board did not recommend.

### Board of Studies Meeting Report – 2017-2018 – 24.2.2018


The Board of Studies meeting for the Department of Economics was held on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2018 at 10.30 a.m. in the department. The meeting started with a prayer. The University nominee Dr. Amalanathan, the subject experts Dr. Arputhamani and Dr. Jeya Seela along with the Industrialist Dr. K. B. Raja Stalin and one UG student representative (III B.A. Economics) Ms. Nishanthini Kalyani were present for the Board of Studies Meeting. The members had a discussion with the department staff members about the new UG Course Structure for 2018-21, PG course structure for 2018-19 and syllabus for I B.A. and I M.A. Economics (the Course description, vision, mission and career opportunities and course objectives) and evaluation pattern. The following were the suggestions of the Board members:

- The Board members resolved to approve the UG and PG Course structure and all the courses offered.
- They went through the syllabus for the I and II semesters of UG and all the four semesters for PG. The core papers and allied papers for I B.A. Economics and allied papers offered by the department for I B.A. History were minutely reviewed and they recommended some corrections in it which were carried out.
- The board resolved to carry out certain additions and deletions in the proposed syllabi, keeping in view of the latest developments in the field of economics and the Board resolved to accept the proposed new course structure and syllabi for I B.A., I M.A. Economics and Allied papers for I B.A. History.
- The board members resolved to recommend a list of standardised Text Books and leading list encompassing the syllabus and its contents.
- They also suggested to change the title of the paper on Economics of Shipping as International Economics and suggested to change the contents in some of the papers. They also stressed to give importance to some topics in Indian Economy.
- Our Industrialist explained the importance of exports and imports and suggested to include EXIM policies for the benefit of the students. He focussed the challenges and opportunities available to the women entrepreneurs all over the world while discussing the course on "Women Entrepreneurship".
- The board resolved to follow the new evaluation pattern as it is relevant and appropriate.
- The feedback forms on curriculum were collected from the Board Members.



**2017 - 2019**







- The feedback forms on curriculum were collected from the board members.




### Board of Studies Meeting Report – 2017-2018 – 24.2.2018


