

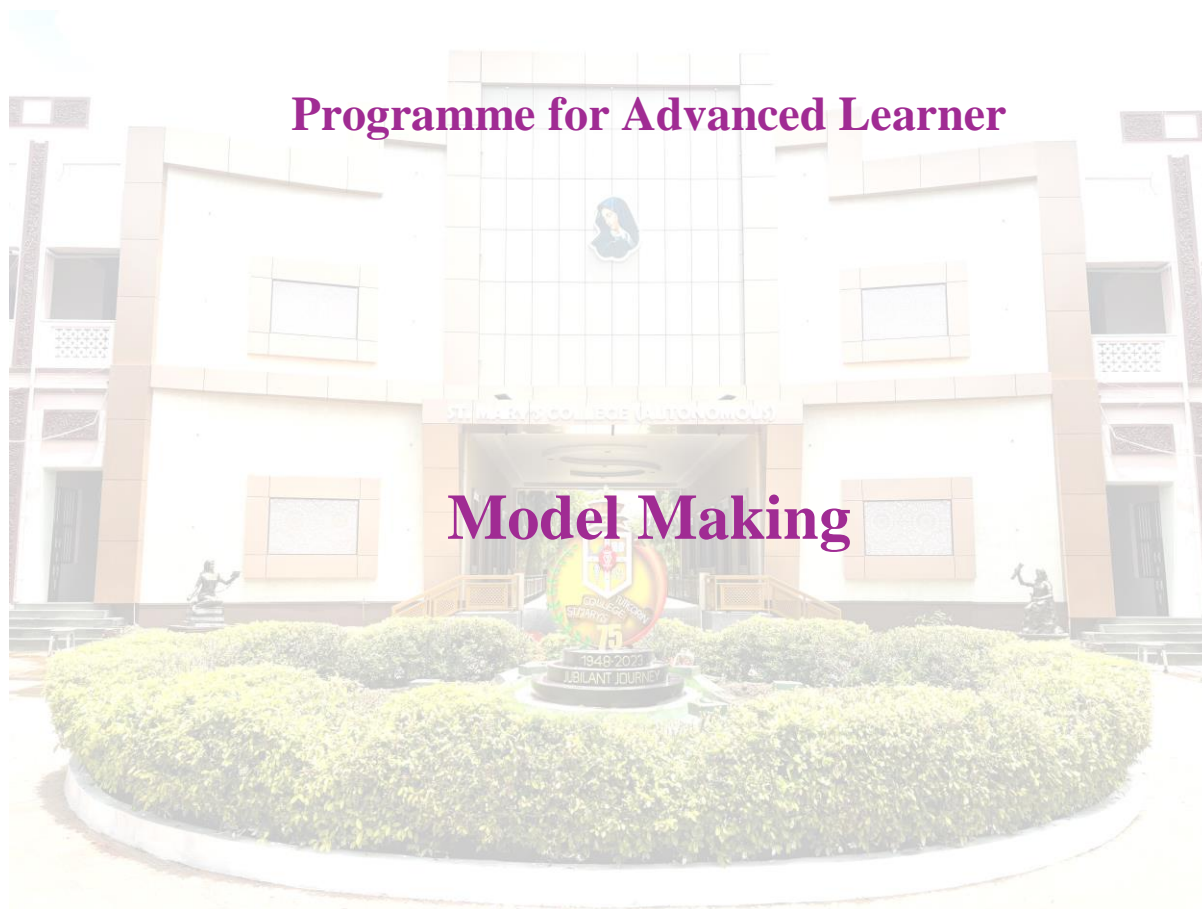

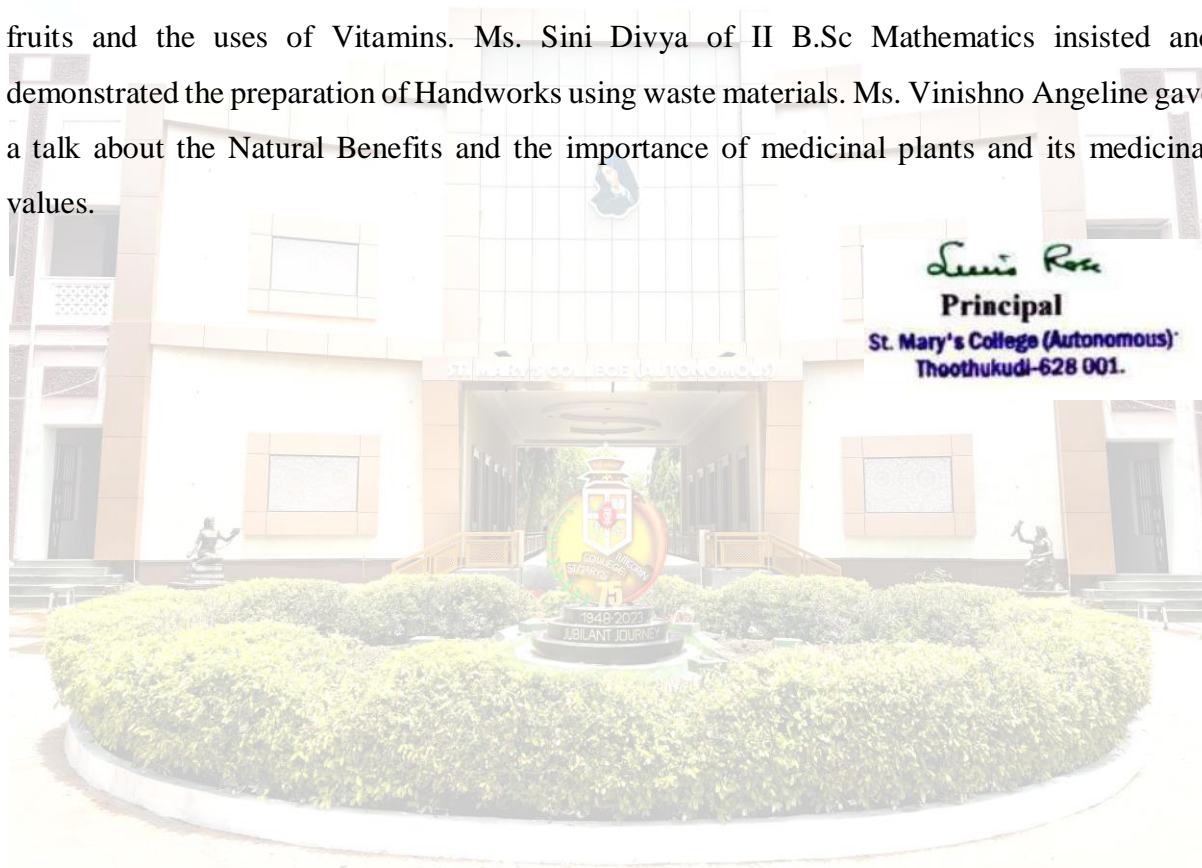
Inter-School working model exhibition
