- In the present work the fishery resources were made into a valuable edible product and this will pave the way to alleviate the serious malnutrition problems. Hence it is decided to prepare value added products and popularize their nutritive value through modern useful recipes.
 - Value addition and conversion of the fish raw materials to different types of products were developed.
- The value products like fish balls, fish chips, fish pickle, prawn pickle, dry fish chutney powder, dry prawn chutney powder and fish momos were prepared.
- Based on the upcoming generation preference to new products that were easily available and readily feasible were exploradded ed.
