### **PREAMBLE**

## THE PRINCIPLES


Both the institutions will abide by the following principles:

- The purpose of the Memorandum of Understanding is only to express the intentions of these two institutions and is not intended to be a legal binding on either institutions.
- This Memorandum of Understanding imposes no financial obligations on either institution.
- Each institution will carry out its separate activities in a coordinated and mutually beneficial manner.
- Each institution shall designate a liaison person to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.
- This memorandum shall remain in effect till termination by either institution upon 60 days' notice to the other institution.
- The representatives of the institutions can meet as and when necessary to review progress in the implementation of the agreed arrangement, define new areas and programmes of cooperation as well as discuss matters related to MoU.



This MoU shall be valid for a period of 5 years (2020-2021 to 2024-2025) and can be renewed for a further period of 5 years on mutual consent.



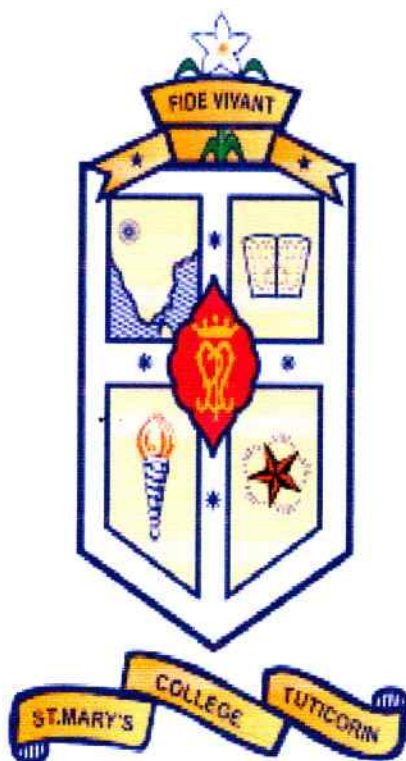

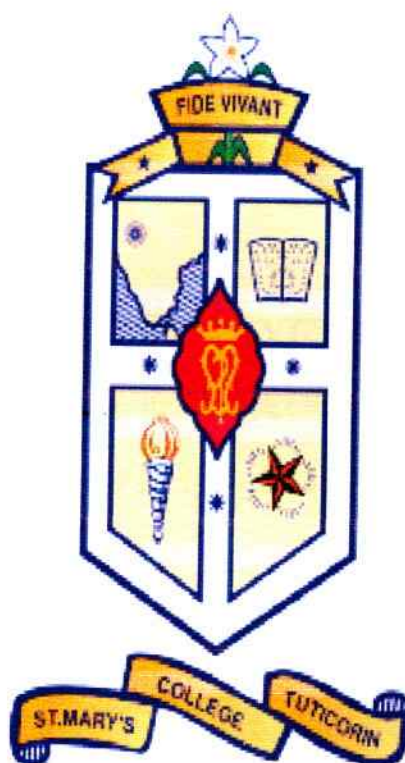
