

# > Report

A three - day Faculty Development programme on Natural Product Research was conducted by the school of Biological Sciences under the Star College Programme of St.Mary's College (Autonomous) Thoothukudi on 2<sup>nd</sup>to4<sup>th</sup> January 2020. Dr. Aneesh Nair, Scientist and Head of Operations, Mr. Shanmuga Sundaram, Senior Researcher, Ms. Chandralekha, Junior Researcher of Biozone Research Technologies, Pvt. Ltd. Chennai were the resource persons. Faculty of School of Biological Sciences (Departments of Botany and Zoology) participated in the faculty Development Programe. Dr. Aneesh Nair gave a hands-on training on various softwares for drug designing and docking. Mr. Shanmuga Sundaram and Ms. Chandralekha demonstrated experiments to

extract bioactive compounds from natural products. They also taught the participants various assays to validate the bioactive compounds of the extract. It included assays for antioxidant, antidiabetic and anti-inflammatory activity. The two-day FDP was very helpful for faculty whose research area is identifying and prospecting bioactive compounds from natural products.

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# TWO-DAY HANDS-ON TRAINING ON BACTERIAL ISOLATION, IDENTIFICATION AND BIOFILM FORMATION

As part of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between St. Mary's College, Thoothukudi, and the Centre for Bioscience Nanoscience Research (CBNR) in Coimbatore, a two-day hands-on training was held on September 27th and 28th, 2019, at CBNR. Dr. G. Flora, Assistant Professor of Botany, along with students from various science Departments at St. Mary's College, J. Emelda Agnes Fernando, P. Santhana Thiyaga Lakshmi, and X. Agustina from III B.Sc. Physics; K. Sherine from III B.Sc. Zoology; C. Muthu Valliammal and K. Ebina from III B.Sc. Botany; and A. Infy Shiny, S. Mareeawari, and S. Dhishani Athiba from III B.Sc. Chemistry participated in this training. This training programme was c onducted by Dr. Ragunathan, Director of CBNR, and Dr. Kabesh, Biotechnologist at CBNR, the training covered essential techniques in bacterial isolation, identification, and biofilm formation. This workshop equipped students with practical microbiological skills, serving as foundational preparation for their interdepartmental project on "Bacterial Degradation of Microplastics," a topic of significant environmental interest. Through this training, students gained valuable experience in microbial analysis, which will aid them in exploring bacterial approaches to degrade microplastics. This collaborative event fostered academic partnership and practical learning, empowering students to address environmental challenges through research-based solutions.



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
