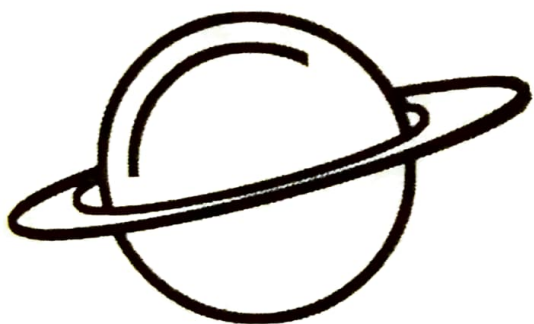

Climate Change

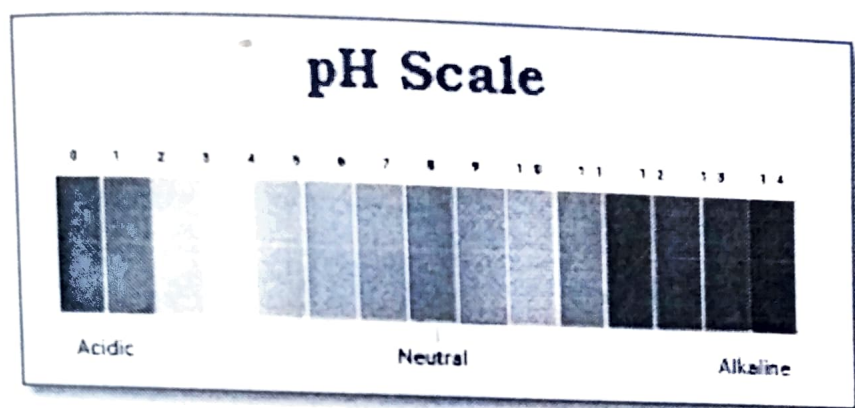
Many years ago, individuals living in the earth started burning huge quantities of coal, oil, and natural gas to power their homes, factories, and vehicles. Nowadays, most of the world relies on these fossil fuels for their energy needs. Burning fossil fuels releases carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide, unburned hydrocarbon, a heat-trapping gas, into the atmosphere, which is the main reason for climate change. Heat-trapping gases are also called greenhouse gases. They exist naturally in the atmosphere, where they help keep the Earth warm enough for plants and animals to live. But people are adding extra greenhouse gases to the atmosphere. These extra gases are causing the Earth to get warmer, setting off all sorts of other changes around the world—on land, in the oceans, and in the atmosphere. And these changes were affected the people, plants, and animals in many ways.

What is pH and pH scale?

To begin with the pH concept was introduced by Danish and Soren in the year 1909 at the Carlsberg Laboratory. The pH scale is a grade of solutions in terms of how acidic or how basic they are. It point out the concentration of hydrogen ions (H^+) and hydroxide ions (OH^-) in a solution. These ion concentrations are equal in pure water, which has a pH of 7.



On the Basis of Lewis acid-base definition, the pH scale was developed by the absolute chemical potential of the proton. The pH scale measurement is applicable for liquids, gases and solid phenomena. A new -Unified absolute pH scale proposed on 2010, which would allow various pH ranges across different solutions to use a common proton reference standard.

The Ocean

The Ocean is a huge salt water body that covers about 70 % of the Earth's Surface. The Planet has only one global ocean, though Ocean experts and the nations of the world has

divided into distinct geographic regions viz. The Indian ocean, The Pacific Ocean, The Atlantic Ocean, The Arctic Ocean and The Antarctic Ocean. Ocean acidity is presently affecting the entire ocean, including coastal estuaries and water bodies. In our food chain fish and shellfishes are unavoidable and many jobs and economies are related with Ocean.

How Ocean Gets Acidified?

As carbon dioxide (CO_2) dissolves in sea water, it forms carbonic acid, decreasing the ocean's pH, a process collectively known as ocean acidification. Present ocean acidification occurs approximately ten times faster than anything experienced during the last 300 million years, jeopardising the ability of ocean systems to adapt to changes in ocean chemistry due to CO_2 . Ocean acidification has the potential to change marine ecosystems and impact many ocean-related benefits to society such as coastal protection or provision of food and income. Increasing the ocean temperatures and oxygen loss act concurrently with ocean acidification and constitute the 'deadly trio' of climate change pressures on the marine environment. To combat the worst effects of the deadly trio, CO_2 emissions need to be cut significantly and immediately at the source. Sustainable management, conservation, restoration and strong, permanent protection of at least 30% of the ocean are urgently needed.

Increasing acidity will make it harder for corals to build skeletons and for shellfish to build the shells they need for

protection. Corals are particularly important because they provide homes for many other sea creatures.

Though the oceans cover more than 70 percent of Earth, only 20 percent is visible to us. So are usually only able to see the water at the surface, not most of it, the other 80 percent.

Plants, Animals and Ecosystems

Most plants and animals live in areas with very specific climate conditions, such as temperature and rainfall patterns, that enable them to thrive. Any change in the climate of an area can affect the plants and animals living there, as well as the makeup of the entire ecosystem. Some species are already responding to a warmer climate by moving to cooler locations. For example, some North American animals and plants are moving farther north or to higher elevations to find suitable places to live. Climate change also alters the life cycles of plants and animals. For example, as temperatures get warmer, many plants are starting to grow and bloom earlier in the spring and survive longer into the fall. Some animals are waking from hibernation sooner or migrating at different times, too.

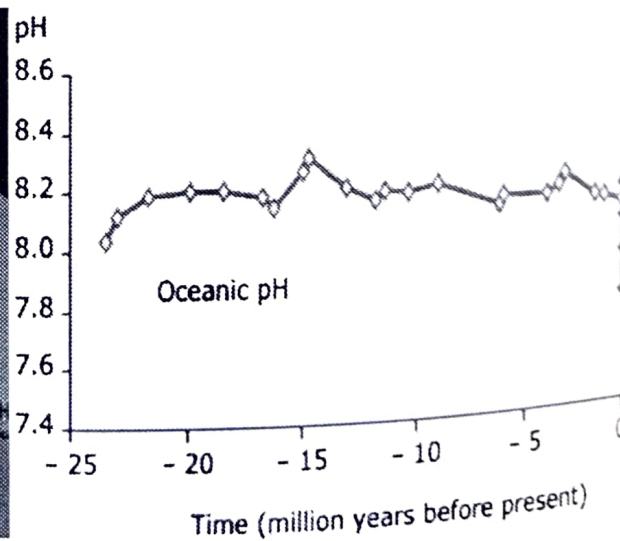
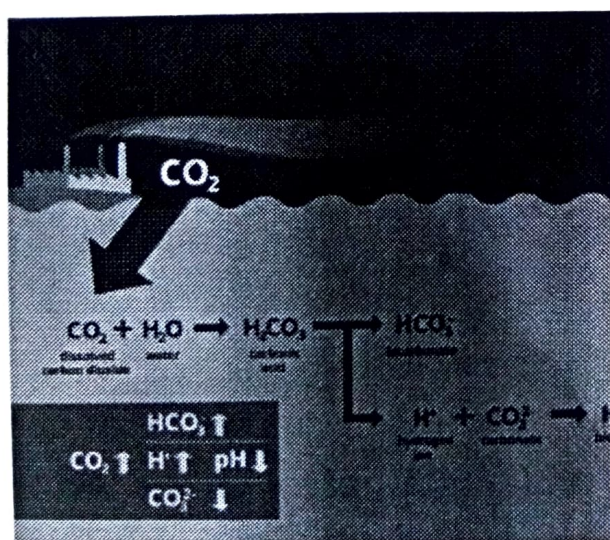
Disappearing Habitats

As the Earth gets warmer, plants and animals that need to live in cold places, like on mountaintops or in the Arctic, might not have a suitable place to live. If the Earth keeps getting warmer, up to one-fourth of all the plants and animals

on Earth could become extinct within 100 years. Every plant and animal plays a role in the ecosystem (for example, as a source of food, a predator, a pollinator, a source of shelter), so losing one species can affect many others.

Coral Reefs

Coral reefs are created in shallow tropical waters by millions of tiny animals called corals. Each coral makes a skeleton for itself, and over time, these skeletons build up to create coral reefs, which provide habitat for lots of fish and other ocean creatures. Warmer water has already caused coral bleaching (a type of damage to corals) in many parts of the world. By 2050, live corals could become rare in tropical and sub-tropical reefs due to the combined effects of warmer water and increased ocean acidity caused by more carbon dioxide in the atmosphere. The loss of coral reefs will reduce habitats for many other sea creatures, and it will disrupt the food web that connects all the living things in the ocean.



Solutions to minimize the impacts on Earth/Ocean

a Greener approaches

Steps forwarded to more resource efficient and design molecules, materials, products and processes safely.

b Greener Vehicles

Vehicles manufactures against combustion engine, worked with diesel, gasoline and work in environmental friendly.

c Energy efficient materials

Eliminating energy waste for every work and less energy usage for the same.

d Wind energy

Producing electricity by wind power/energy, is the another form of solar energy.

e Bio Energy

Renewable energy producing from organic matter, living organic materials either matter.

f Water Energy
