#### Introduction

The fifth largest planet of the solar system – Earth, is the only planet known to have an atmosphere containing free oxygen and oceans of water on its surface and to maintain life. Naturally earth has green house effect. The green house effect is the trapping of energy from the sun by certain gases in the atmosphere leading to rise in earth's temperature. Carbon dioxide, nitrous oxide, methane, water vapour and chlorofluorocarbon absorb and reflect infra red waves radiated by earth and hence conserve heat as in a green house. All the living organisms need this green house effect for its survival. If not, the earth will be cooled and ice will cover the earth from pole to pole.

The most abundant green house gas is CO<sub>2</sub> which comes to the atmosphere due to anthropogenic and natural activities. CO<sub>2</sub> is removed by plants through photosynthesis and absorbed by ocean water. #### Abstract:

Sea foods are currently in high demand and are considered as healthy and nutritional. Tunicates commonly known as sea squirts occupy an important link in the food chain and indirectly provide humans with a source of food. It contains bioactive compounds as their secondary metabolites and some of these may prove useful as drugs. Some tunicates are fouling organisms that grow on hull of ships and other harbor installations. Various other species are also known as sea pork as it has nutritive value in its content.

Key words: Tunicates, sea food, fouling organisms, sea squirts, sea pork.

#### INTRODUCTION

Oceans cover over 70% of the earth's surface and carry out about 50% of global primary production and support the greatest biodiversity on the planet. Oceans provide both living and nonliving resources. Living resources are an important source of seafood. More than 60% of the world's population living on the coastline depends on various creatures such as seaweeds, finfish, crustaceans, molluses, echinoderms, tunicates, reptiles, birds and marine mammals etc. for their food. Ocean is the number one source of protein for more than a billion people and the importance of seafood in the human diet varies greatly around the world. In recent years, the popularity of seafood has been increased because it is seen as a health-promoting food source. Tunicates live exclusively on marine environments, unable to survive in lowsalinities. They are prochordates. Some ascidians are monascidians, simple and solitary forms. Some are found in groups, the social ascidians, in which individuals are separate, but connected by stolonic vessels.

The outer surface of an ascidian is covered by a thick tunic or test. Because of the presence of tunic, they are called as tunicates. The tunic is composed of a carbohydrate, and some amount of it is a cellulose-like compound called tunicin. The ascidians settle on all kinds of surfaces, are commonly called as sea squirts since they squirt out water when they are detatched from their substratum. About 3,000 species of tunicate exist in the world's oceans, living mostly in shallow water. Ascidians occupy a unique evolutionary position between vertebrate and invertebrate as they exhibit vertebrate like tadpole characteristics in larval form and in adult form as invertebrate filter feeders. Rapid evolution of tunicate genomes with their short lifespan and the two modes of reproduction are responsible for the diversity and the adaptability of ascidians, which reflect the structural novelty and the functional diversity of this particular species.

Sea food products are currently in high demand and they are considered healthy and nutritional. Though food products are prepared from a number of marine organisms like prawn, molluses, fishes etc., ascidians are also farmed and fished in many parts of the world for food. Tunicates are consumed as food in a variety of preparations in different parts of the world and are considered as highly nutritious seafood when consumed just after harvest is favored for the best flavor. Various Ascidiacea species are consumed as food around the world. In Japan and Korea, the sea pineapple (*Halocynthia roretzi*) is the main species eaten. It is cultivated on dangling cords made of palm fronds. The tunic of the pyurid ascidian *Microcosmus hartmeyeri*
