





Report of the Career Guidance & Placement cell for the Academic Year 2018-2019

The business meeting of Career Guidance & Placement cell was held on 9th July 2018 under the guidance of our staff members to elect the office bearers. Vaishnavi of III B.Sc Mathematics, R. Dhanuja of III B.A English and S. N. Mary Angel of II B.A English (SSC) were elected as President, Secretary and Vice President respectively.

Career Guidance & Placement cell aims to motivate the aptitude of student preference of job and to train students to meet the challenges of latest technology and development.
