



MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

The Board of Studies Meeting of the Department of Economics was conducted on 01.02.2020 at 10.30 A.M in the department of Economics.

No. of Members Present

External Members : 7

Internal Members : 8

The Chairperson Ms. X. Esther Vimala welcomed and introduced the Members. All the members were present for the meeting.

Agenda Discussion:

The Chairperson presented the agenda and invited the members for discussion.

Agenda Item No.1

MOOC Online course – It is mandatory for PG students to complete one MOOC during the first year of study. If the students fail, they appear for supplementary exam and the institution will provide the certificate. No extra credit will be given.

Discussion:

In the first agenda external members pointed out that in order to enhance student's knowledge, they need not opt the same course from their own subject, instead they can opt for any other related online course. They also expressed the view that compulsory MOOC Online Course is not a flexible system. Legal problem may arise in getting e-certificates and a degree can't be withheld if they have missed to complete online MOOC Course.

Conclusion:

The members concluded that Online MOOC Course can be kept optional, but not a compulsory criteria and no additional credit should be allotted for it.

Agenda Item No.2

Certificate Course & Career Oriented Course

- Ability Enhancement Courses will be conducted in the afternoon. So, there is no Certificate Course for II Years.
- I & III UG students have Certificate & Career Oriented courses for 30 hours instead of 60 hours during the odd semester.

Discussion:

Discussions were held regarding problems faced by II Year students in case of their certificate courses due to Ability Enhancement Courses and CDP (UBA) and also about III Year certificate course hours.

Conclusion:

The members accepted the reasons for no certificate course for the II year students. For the III Year career oriented course, the hours can be reduced to 30 provided the syllabus should also be framed for to 30 hours instead of 60 hours.

Agenda Item No.3

Change in CIA Evaluation Pattern – Average of all the three tests will be taken instead of the best two.

Discussion:

The benefits and problems of having three CIA's and two CIA's were discussed. Two external members insisted on only two CIA's as staffs will get more working hours and they can focus on innovative teaching methods and their implementation.

Conclusion:

It was finalised that if there are three CIA's, then average of best two CIA's should be taken for consideration, otherwise we can have only two CIA's.

Recommendations

- Regarding the MOOC Course, it was recommended that MOOC Online Course • should not be mandatory.
- No certificate course for II year students
- With regard to certificate course and career oriented courses, the members recommended that II years need not have certificate courses and III year certificate course hours should be reduced to 30 hours and syllabus should be framed accordingly.
- With relation to CIA's, there can be only two CIA's and if there are three CIA's then, the average of only best two CIA's should be taken.

Resolution

- The Board placed the following suggestions:
- It was resolved that MOOC Online courses should not be mandatory.
- It was resolved that no certificate course for II years and III year certificate course should be reduced to 30 hours and syllabus to be framed accordingly.
- It was resolved to introduce Tally as Career Oriented Course for the III Years 0 students.
- It was resolved to have only two CIA's.

The above resolutions were acknowledged and accepted by the Board. The meeting ended with the vote of thanks by Dr. Muthu Maha Laxmi.
