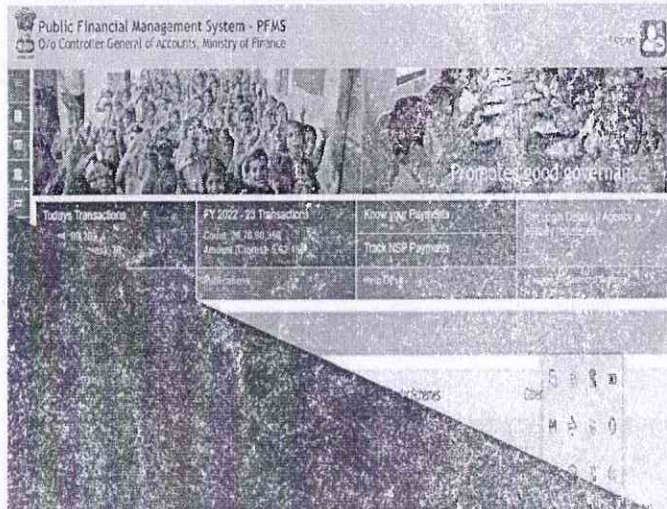

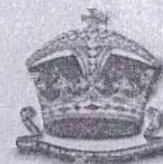

About PFMS

The Public Financial Management System (PFMS) is a web-based online software application developed and implemented by the office of Controller General of Accounts (CGA). PFMS was initially started during 2009 as a Central Sector Scheme of Planning Commission with the objective of tracking funds released under all Plan schemes of Government of India (GoI), and real time reporting of expenditure at all levels of Programme implementation. Subsequently in the year 2013, the scope was enlarged to cover direct payment to beneficiaries under both Plan and non-Plan Schemes. The latest enhancement in the functionalities of PFMS commenced in late 2014, wherein it has been envisaged that digitization of accounts shall be achieved through PFMS and the additional functionalities would be built into PFMS in different stages. Beginning with Pay & accounts Offices payments, the O/o CGA did further value addition by proposing to bring in more financial activities of the GOI in the ambit of the project.

The primary objective of PFMS is to facilitate sound Public Financial Management System for GoI by establishing an efficient fund flow system as well as a payment cum accounting network. PFMS provides various stakeholders with a real time, reliable and meaningful management information system and an effective decision support system, as part of the Digital India initiative of GoI. The biggest strength of PFMS is its integration with the Core banking system in the Country. As a result, PFMS the unique capability to push online payments to almost every beneficiary/vendor. At present, PFMS interface is having interface in addition to the Core Banking System (CBS) of all Public Sector Banks, Regional Rural Banks, major private sector banks, Reserve Bank of India, India post and Cooperative Banks.

Scope of the Workshop

To resolve issues relating to All the schemes from which the institutions would be receiving funds. Individual issues of all institutions will be addressed and resolved. Any issue that is unresolved would be cleared withing due time by Sr. Account Officer, PFMS. During the workshop, Sr. Account officer, PFMS will create two users - one person to work as data operator - who would initiate the transaction and one data approver who would approve the transaction (their name, personal mobile no-for password recovery and email address would be required) The officials attending the workshop should bring with them the cash book of UGC account (or RUSA or DST or DBT as the case may be) and also the details of vendors to whom they regularly make payment or have made payment for previous year (vendor name, bank name and account no and other available details).

Two Staff from a College can attend. One of them could be the UGC Coordinator and one accounts person duly authorized by the Head of the Institution.

Those who come representing their institution should carry their PFMS login id (UNIQUE ID) and password or should be authorized to retrieve the same on behalf of the institution. A Topics covered on PFMS would be - Fund Management, User Management, Vendor Management Expenditure Filing (EAT Module) Payment Module & Reports.

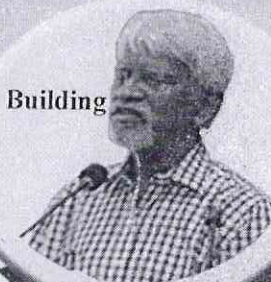

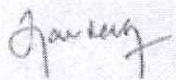

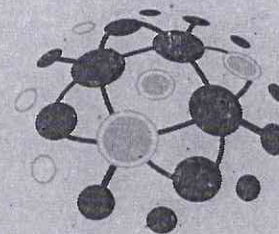

Background

Following the work of David Kolb and others, in experiential-learning engine, a learner experiences a transformation while passing through the spiral of experience of knowledge, reflecting on the experience, abstract conceptualisation and planning for further action. This is an interplay between objectivity and subjectivity while experiencing to conceptualisation is grasping or comprehending axis whereas reflection to planning or further action is transformation axis. These two axes together constitute experiential learning plane pivoted on the neuro-psychic system of the learner, learner's personal preferences and the learning environment, which may be collectively called the learning space. Learning curve spirals upward around the vertical axis to this plane which is dependent on the style of learning of the learner.

Teachers objectively create learning spaces by the information and activities they offer in their course, but this space is also interpreted in the students' subjective experience through the lens of their learning style. In the process of learning as experiencing knowledge, the human brain plays a vital role as the central governing system to map the images of learning in the human brain which may be called educational neuroscience. It provides means to develop a common language and bridge the gap between educators, psychologists and neuroscientists. The emerging field of educational neuroscience presents opportunities as well as challenges for education. The most effective learning involves recruiting multiple regions of the brain for the learning task. These regions are associated with such functions as memory, the various senses, volitional control, and higher levels of cognitive functioning. By considering biological factors, research has advanced the understanding of specific

learning difficulties, such as dyslexia and dyscalculia. Likewise, neuroscience is uncovering why certain types of learning are more rewarding than others. The brain changes constantly as a result of learning and remains 'plastic' throughout life to construct spiral of learning development. Neuroscience has shown that learning a skill changes the brain and that these changes revert when practice of the skill ceases. Hence 'use it or lose it' is an important principle for lifelong learning. Resilience, our adaptive response to stress and adversity, can be built up through education with lifelong effects into old age. Both the acquisition of knowledge and mastery of self-control benefit future learning. Thus, neuroscience has a key role in investigating means of boosting brainpower. Some insights from neuroscience are relevant for the development and use of adaptive digital or artificial intelligence technologies.

A lot of research has gone in the field of neural network in computer science and robotics. It is worthwhile to consider these research areas in investigating the interplay between the human brain and human formal/natural learning. These technologies have the potential to create more learning opportunities inside and outside the classroom and throughout life. This is exciting given the knock-on effects this could have on well-being, health, employment and the economy. The learning style and adaptability to learning space are special to each individual and therefore learning depends on the neuro-systemic influence on the personality of the learner. Following this theme the conference networks neuroscience, educational psychology and pedagogy. The deliberations in the conference may open-up areas of interdisciplinary research.

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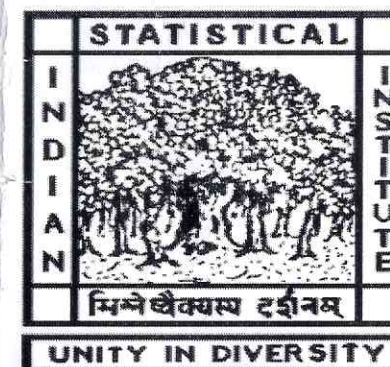
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ABOUT THE CONFERENCE
