

Recycling system

- The college provides basic recycling service throughout the campus by keeping separate bins for biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes.
- Proper solid waste management is practiced in the campus. The fallen leaves/ twigs/ paper waste and other debris are properly collected and composted with modern techniques (Composting/Vermicomposting/vermiwash)
 - The composted manures were tested for their physico-chemical and biological parameters. The results of the study showed that vermicomposting of fallen leaves is a successful method of recycling.
