Coastal Cleanup Programme in Thoothukudi



A coastal cleanup programme was organised by the Centre for Eco Feminine Excellence of St. Mary's College (Autonomous) Thoothukudi on 16th September 2019. In lieu of International Ozone day, a Coastal cleanup programme was organised for the students of various departments of the college in the Pearl City coast area under the theme of Plastic Free Environment. Around 100 students and 10 staff members participated in the programme. The programme started with the rally which was flagged by Dr. A.S.J. Lucia Rose, Principal, St. Mary's College (Autonomous) Thoothukudi. The rally reached the beach after which students collected the wastes and segregated them into biodegradable and non biodegradable wastes in separate baskets. The students were provided with pamphlets with environment related slogans. Students actively participated in the rally as well as the cleanup programme.
