7.1.9 Sensitization of Students and Employees of the Institution to Constitutional Obligations Values, Rights, Duties and Responsibilities of Citizens:

The second meeting of the consumer club was held on 26th September 2019. The meeting was presided over by Mr.S.Ruban Kishore, Advocate, Member, Juvenile Justice Board, Thoothukudi. He delivered a speech on “Legal status and rights of women and children in Indian constitution”.



The Centre for Women’s Excellence ensures active functioning of all the forums that comes under its functioning regularly, under the guidance of Dr. S. Sudha Rani and Dr. P. Banumathi, the Director and Assistant Director for this centre. The Anti- Ragging Cell conducted an awareness meeting on 23 July 2019. Mr I. P. Balasekar B. The cell functions with the following objectives:


- To create awareness among students of sexual harassment.
